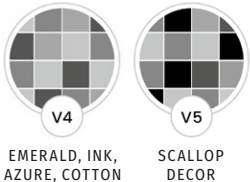


WIGHTWICK

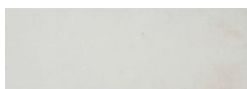
