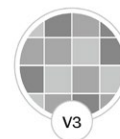


TORA BLUE

LIMESTONE - TUMBLED

This inky-black European limestone is covered in minute off-white fossils, which are softened in effect by the tumbled finish for a refined Flemish feel.

TECHNICAL DATA

Petrographic Analysis

A compact blue-grey limestone, of sedimentary origin, resulting from the accumulation of innumerable fossilised crinoid articles and fragments cemented into a mass of microcrystalline calcite. The stone also contains other fossils such as shells (including brachiopods), corals and bryozoans.

White veins and fine irregular black veins (stylolites) are spread over the surface.

The stone is a bioclastic, crinoid dominant limestone. It is a pack stone, sometimes grain stone (DUNHAM classification) or a biomicrite (FOLK classification). The average composition is 96 to 99% carbonates, 0 to 1% quartz, 0.2 to 0.5% iron salts (mainly sulphides) and 0.2 to 0.4% organic carbon.
